Art Prize: Friends of the McKay Memorial Gardens.

The FMMG will offer three separate art prizes for images of (or responding to) the McKay Memorial Gardens, Anderson Road Sunshine:

1. Junior Art Prize (up to year seven)
2. Senior Art Prize (year seven and above)
3. Senior Photographic Prize (year seven and above)

Submissions judged the winner in each section will be awarded a certificate "First Prize" to the student and \$500 will be awarded to the contributing school.

Second and third prize certificates will also be awarded to contributing students so judged in each section.

Conditions:

1. Each submission must be accompanied by a submission form to be signed by a teacher.
2. Submissions for the Junior and Senior Art Prize can be in any two dimensional medium.
3. Submissions for the Senior Photographic Prize must be a photograph but can be taken with any photographic equipment.
4. All submissions must be no larger than A3 in size (photographs should be no larger than 11" x 14")
5. All submissions must have the student's name and school attached to the reverse side.
6. All submissions must be delivered between Monday 11th and Friday 15th October to the:

7. **NB: Submissions will not be accepted after 4.00pm on Friday 15th October**

All submissions will be exhibited in the Sunshine Plaza and Market Place shopping centers on Harvester Road, Sunshine between 17th and 23rd October.

Entries will be judged by Jo Ely, Visual Arts Curator Hunt Club Community Arts Centre, Brimbank City Council. Judging will occur on the 18th of October, the judge's decision is final and no negotiations will be entered into. Schools will be notified on the same day in the case of winning entries.

Entries can be collected from the Hunt Club Community Arts Centre between 26th and 29th October (inclusive), or can be donated to the archive of the Friends of the McKay Memorial Gardens. Uncollected entries will be held by the Friends Group.

While all care will be taken in the handling of submission, the Friends of the McKay Gardens can take no responsibility for damage or loss of submissions.
